CERTIFICATION WORKSHOP FOR INSTRUCTORS PROVIDING DRIVER TRAINING TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Course Purpose

To provide a specialized training program for driving instructors seeking certification from the Ohio Department of Public Safety to teach driver training to individuals with disabilities. To provide current information and training to anyone who works with and trains people with disabilities.

Course Objectives

- Participants will be able to identify the general characteristics associated with various types of disabilities and their implications for driving and assessment.
- Participants will gain an understanding of the driver rehabilitation process and the importance of networking with a hospital, CDRS or other certified medical facility.
- Participants will gain an understanding of the driver rehabilitation process and the related reports and documentation
- Participants will be able to identify the specific driver training considerations for individuals with disabilities.
- Participants will be able to identify the general characteristics associated with developmental disabilities and their implications for driving assessment and training.
- Participants will be able to identify various types of adaptive driving controls and systems and their operational characteristics.
- Participants will gain a hands-on understanding of current driving equipment and modifications and how to use them correctly.
- Participants will gain an understanding of how to control a client and the vehicle during an assessment and training.

This workshop is being offered to certify you in this specialty area of driver training – working with people who have disabilities. To qualify for the certification, you must complete both days of training. If you are already certified to teach disabilities and are looking for Continuing Education credits, you may attend either day.

It is designed to be an introduction to instructors to provide a quality, standardized driver training program for persons with disabilities.

Requirements to attend:

You must have at least two years of training as a Driving Instructor or be certified as a Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist, or other related medical field. If you are already certified in this area and wish to obtain 8 CEU credits (through ADED), you may attend either day. This course will also satisfy the State of Ohio continuing education credits for disabilities instructors.
