

Health and Safety Notice:

NOTICE: In accordance with Governor DeWine's statewide mask order, **all customers taking an in-car skills test will be required to wear a facial covering that covers the customer's nose, mouth, and chin at all times during the test**, in order to keep our customers and driver examiners safe. Prior to the test, customers will be required to have their temperature taken at the driver examination station and to answer questions about potential symptoms and exposure to COVID-19.

Customers will not be permitted to take the test if they:

- refuse to properly wear a facial covering for the test
- have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher
- are currently isolating or quarantining
- have a COVID-19 test pending
- have or have had symptoms of COVID - 19 within the last ten days
- have been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID - 19 in the last 14 days

To help keep you safe, the BMV is taking the following steps:

- Examiners will wear a mask at all times.
- Examiners will undergo a screening each morning to check their temperature, symptoms, and potential exposure to COVID - 19. Examiners who do not pass the screening will not be permitted to conduct in-car testing.
- Examiners will practice proper hand hygiene, to include frequent washing and use of hand sanitizer when appropriate.
- The BMV will follow CDC guidelines for disinfecting high touch items(pens, clipboards, etc.) after each test.

Please note: If you require an accommodation in conjunction with the American's with Disabilities Act, please contact the Ohio Department of Public Safety's ADA office by emailing Toby Chambliss at tdchambliss@dps.ohio.gov or Bryon Brown at bmbrown@dps.ohio.gov BEFORE scheduling your test. **Same day accommodation requests will result in having to re-schedule a driving exam.**
